SHOW REPORT - HENDRICK'S GIN CANADA TOUR

This summer Circus Orange stepped out of their usual steam-punk pyro style and toured the country promoting <u>Hendrick's Gin</u> with a mix of Edwardian and Victorian garbed street performers. The artists created a meandering, theatrical absurdity that took people back in time with poetry, penny farthings, stilting, tea time, follies, laughter, flirting, window shopping and a whimsical tipple of gin at various locations. There was no shortage of cucumbers – a Hendrick's staple that find their way into many a drink.

This is a similar effect to the CO2 Jets that create a quick column of smoke only these are more repeatable as they run off a smoke machine and compressed air. Better for the environment too! we were asked to create 40 minutes of straight up fire and pyro performances at Yonge-Dundas Square. The crowd stayed glued to the stage as our performers worked their magic with all sorts of fire and pyro props with our propane fire dragons in the background. Other acts in this show included drummers and our world famous flamethrower trampoline act. Fun!
